If an employee is injured, Taylor Bros Transport Ltd will, where practicable, fully participate in a rehabilitation programme, committing to ensuring the safe and early return to work of any injured employee.

We expect and encourage our directors and managers, to engage with our customers, employees, contractors, and other stakeholders to ensure that our operation and management system considers their needs and expectations. We actively involve employees and seek feedback to improve our management system.

The management team, coordinated by the GM HR / HSE, ensure regular review and documentation control of our health and safety management system which will be reviewed by management and staff at least annually.
